The Marshall County Board of Education met in regular session Tuesday, March 9, 2010, 7:30 p.m., at the Offices of the Board of Education, all members having been notified of business to be considered.

Present were: President Roger A. Lewicki; Vice President David L. Hall; Members Mary Ellen Komorowski, Thomas E. Gilbert, Jr., Lori E. Kestner; Secretary Alfred N. Renzella; Members of the County Administrative Staff.

The Board met and conferred with representatives from the Local School Improvement Councils of McNinch Primary and Central Elementary.

Rita DeMundo, Principal, introduced Amy Trowbridge, Teacher, who spoke on behalf of McNinch Primary School Improvement Council. Mrs. Trowbridge said this school year has mostly been a transition year. She reviewed with the Board facility updates and school events.

Karen Klamut, Principal, spoke on behalf of the Central School Improvement Council. Mrs. Klamut stated their goals are to continue to meet the standards designated by No Child Left Behind, continue to increase positive behavior, increase parent involvement and advancement of technology.
