The Marshall County Board of Education met in special session/workshop Wednesday, April 21, 2010, 7:30 p.m., at the Offices of the Board of Education, all members having been notified of business to be considered.

This workshop is for the purpose of discussion of the JMHS Flood Study.

Allison Carmichael of McKinley & Associates presented the plans and maps of the Phase II Flood Study options for remediation of the JMHS flooding.

The Board was informed of the Army Corps involvement. At this time they are conducting their own studies and are in contact with their legal department.

Questions were asked about the cost of building a new bridge with a larger span. An estimated cost of \$700,000 was projected. The Board requests that this investigated study be submitted to our legal counsel.

Motion by Mrs. Kestner and seconded by Mr. Gilbert that the meeting be adjourned. Motion carried.
