

CHAPTER 5

5.6 Free Textbooks, Supplies and Workbooks (Revised 04/13/04)

5.6.1 Free Textbooks

The Marshall County Board of Education will provide on a loan basis, free textbooks for pupils in grades K through 12, so long as financial feasibility will permit.

5.6.2 Supplies and Workbooks

The Marshall County Board of Education will furnish all needed and approved workbooks, copy paper and supplies, so long as financial feasibility will permit.

5.6.3 Collection of Monies

Principals and teachers may collect money from pupils for subscriptions, and/or fundraising. All such funds so collected shall be deemed quasi-public moneys, and shall be expended for the benefit of the students of the school. Principals and teachers may also collect money for child nutrition programs, payments for loss or damages to school books, equipment, or buildings and grounds. These funds shall be submitted to the county treasurer. No other collections of monies may be effected without the prior consent of the superintendent.

All monetary transactions shall follow the rules and regulations of the West Virginia Board of Education Accounting Procedures for Public Schools, Policy 1224.1 and W.Va. Code 18-5-13 paragraph (a).
