

CHAPTER 8

8.2 BUS ROUTES

8.2.1 Establishment (Revised 02/28/95)

New school bus routes shall not be established where the distance involved is two miles or less one way from an established bus stop or school attended.

8.2.2 Elimination (Revised 02/28/95)

Where transportation service exists, the route may not be discontinued until such action is directed by the board of education upon the recommendation of the superintendent, unless emergency conditions exist.

8.2.3 Bus Stops

Regular established school bus stops should be at least two-tenths of a mile apart.

8.2.3.1 Shelters

Due to the recurring incidence of vandalism the Board shall continue to provide shelters only in places of greatest need and shall maintain them except when they are intentionally upset or destroyed.

8.2.4 Pupils Living Less Than Two Miles From School

Public school pupils who live on a regular school bus route, two miles or less from their designated school, may be transported on a school bus, provided their enrollment on the bus does not exceed the seating capacity of the bus so assigned.
