

## **CHAPTER 8**

### **8.9 Governing Policies (Revised 02/28/95)**

The Board of Education expects its bus operators and all others associated with school transportation to be fully acquainted with and to respect the policies and rules and regulations governing the transportation of pupils as approved by the Marshall County Board of Education, State Board of Education, State Department of Public Safety (state police) and the State Motor Vehicles Commission.

Transportation of students from school to places other than home for the purpose of participating in instruction in music, dancing, scouting, and other cultural activities may be approved when signed parental requests are on file at the school. It is to be understood that parents are responsible for the child's transportation home. (October 12, 1972)

A daily rate of fifty (50) cents is fixed as payment in lieu of transportation for those students traveling to school bus stop or school by the nearest road or traveled path.
