2.4 Other Authorized Services

The instructional program of Marshall County Schools, where feasible and where a sufficient need is shown, pending the availability of funds, will include the supporting services of administration, supervision, guidance, health, recreation, and specialized services. Below is a listing of areas of special services. Additional information concerning the programs listed may be gleaned from the board adopted "Regulations for the Education of Exceptional Students--W.Va. Dept. of Education--" and the "Marshall County Special Education Policy/Process". (Amended 10/11/94)

- 2.4.1 **Special Education services** are provided for pupils who meet eligibility criteria as specified in the West Virginia Department of Education Regulations for the Education of Exceptional Students.
- 2.4.2 **Guidance and testing** services are made available on as wide a scope as is feasible under existing conditions and facilities.
- 2.4.3 **Vocational education programs** are available to all students.
- 2.4.4 **Speech therapy** is provided for the correction of speech defects by specially trained personnel. This service will be provided as is practical.
- 2.4.5 **Health services** are offered cooperatively with the County Health Department. Nurses' services will be made available according to needs where possible.
- 2.4.6 **Homebound teaching services** will be provided insofar as resources will permit. Homebound instructors will receive salary according to Board's most recent action. (Refer to 5.1.4.3.4, Item 10)
- 2.4.7 **Summer school** may be made available and, if available, will be under the rules and regulations as implemented by the State Board of Education, insofar as resources will permit.
- 2.4.8 **Adult education courses** are offered throughout the county. Classes will be established in subject areas where sufficient interest is shown. Approved guidelines for the operation of adult classes are as follows:

1. The organization and operation of adult classes may include programs in adult basic, adult supplemental, adult preparatory, and community education.
2. Instructors' salaries for all such classes will be subject to Board's most recent action.
3. Authorization is given to employ all such instructors needed, subject to subsequent Board approval.
4. Authorization is given to set tuition fees at an amount so as to represent the difference between the cost of operation and the state/federal support funds available.

2.4.9 General Education Development Test

The General Educational Development Tests are to be administered to eligible candidates by a designee of the superintendent. A fee will be required to be paid by the candidate.
