The Marshall County Board of Education met in workshop session Saturday, February 27, 2016, 8:00 a.m., at the Offices of the Board of Education, all members having been notified of business to be considered.

Present were: President Beth A. Phillips, Vice President Thomas E. Gilbert, Jr., Members Lori E. Kestner, John Miller, Dr. Duane Miller; Secretary Michael Hince, Members of the County Administrative Staff.

Ron Blatt, PCS Project Manager, explained the findings of the structural assessment of Monarch Stadium completed by ECS. The results showed that the stadium was in good condition and that its duration would be another 50 years. Items that need to be addressed are: expansion joints need repaired, visitors' press box needs replaced, and some masonry work needs to be done on joints and cracks.

JTSA Sports presented on artificial turf and the process to have it installed at Monarch Stadium. They explained the installation process and some controversy over the allergies and cancer producing agents that appear in articles and the media and also presented evidence contrary to that and explained different types of fill to use under the turf and gave recommendations.

Motion by Mr. Miller, and seconded by Mrs. Kestner, that the meeting be adjourned. Motion carried.

President Phillips adjourned the workshop at 10:15 a.m.
