President Phillips announced that the Board would go into a closed session for the expulsion of SDA 15/16-07.

President Phillips acted as Hearing Officer.

Motion by Mr. Miller, and seconded by Dr. Duane Miller, that the Board go into closed session for the expulsion of SDA 15/16-07. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Miller, and seconded by Dr. Duane Miller, that the Board come out of closed session and return to special session. Motion carried.

Superintendent Hince's recommendation to the Board is that SDA 15/16-07 be expelled from Sherrard Middle School for a period not to exceed one school year.

Motion by Mrs. Kestner, and seconded by Dr. Duane Miller, that the Board will expel SDA 15/16-07 from Sherrard Middle School for a period not to exceed one school year. Motion carried.
