The Marshall County Board of Education met in workshop session Monday, April 3, 2017, 6:30 p.m., at the Board of Education Offices, all members having been notified of business to be considered.

Present were: President Thomas E. Gilbert, Jr., Vice President John Miller, Members Lori E. Kestner, Dr. Duane Miller, Christie Robison; Secretary Michael Hince, Members of the County Administrative Staff.

Board Members discussed athletic facilities at both Cameron High School and John Marshall High School. It was determined that CHS needs a new locker room and practice wrestling area. JMHS needs artificial turf, which would not be placed until after the 2017 season. Funds cannot be committed until renovations are complete at JMHS and the amount of funds available are known. It was further discussed whether Monarch Stadium should be repaired or some of it be replaced. There was some discussion of the possibility of moving Monarch Stadium to JMHS campus. There will be another meeting to determine the renovations of the stadium.

Motion by Vice President Miller, and seconded by Mrs. Kestner, that the meeting be adjourned. Motion carried.
