The Marshall County Board of Education met in special session Tuesday, March 1, 2011, 7:30 p.m., at the Offices of the Board of Education, all members having been notified of business to be considered.

Present were: President Lewicki; Vice President David L. Hall; Members Thomas E. Gilbert, Jr., Lori E. Kestner, and Beth A. Phillips; Secretary Alfred N. Renzella; Members of the County Administrative Staff.

President Lewicki announced that the Board would go into a closed session for the expulsion hearing.

President Lewicki acted as Hearing Officer.

Thomas N. Wood proffered the student expulsion case.

Present were: student, father and Wendy Lough, caseworker.

Motion by Vice President Hall and seconded by Mrs. Kestner that the Board go into closed session for the expulsion hearing. Motion carried.

Motion by Vice President Hall and seconded by Mr. Gilbert that the Board come out of closed session and return to special session. Motion carried.

Superintendent Renzella's recommendation to the Board is that SDA 10/11-12 be expelled from John Marshall High School for a period not to exceed one school year.

Motion by Mrs. Kestner, seconded by Vice President Hall, and motion carried that the Board will uphold the Superintendent's recommendation to expel SDA 10/11-12 from John Marshall High School for a period not to exceed one school year.

This falls under the habitually violating school rules and policies West Virginia Code 18A-5-1a, the Safe School Statute.

President Lewicki announced a request that the Board go into an executive session as authorized by Chapter 6, Article 9A, Section 4 of the State Code to discuss the Superintendent's Contract.

Motion by Mrs. Kestner and seconded by Vice President Hall that the Board go into executive session. Motion carried.

Motion by Mrs. Kestner and seconded by Mrs. Phillips that the Board come out of executive session and return to special session. Motion carried.
