Present were: Members Thomas E. Gilbert, Jr., Lori E. Kestner, and Beth A. Phillips; Secretary Alfred N. Renzella; Members of the County Administrative Staff with President Roger A. Lewicki and Vice President David L. Hall being absent.

Lori Kestner conducted the meeting.

Motion by Mr. Gilbert and seconded by Mrs. Phillips that the Board approve Budget Revisions FY11. Motion carried.
