The Marshall County Board of Education met in special session Monday, March 11, 2013, 7:00 p.m., at John Marshall High School Center for the Performing Arts, all members having been notified of business to be considered.

Present were: President Roger A. Lewicki, Vice President Lori E. Kestner, Members Thomas E. Gilbert, Jr., John Miller, Beth A. Phillips; Secretary Alfred N. Renzella; Members of the County Administrative Staff.

Kevin Powell, JMHS Broadcasting student, was Master of Ceremonies.

Richard King spoke on behalf of the Ohio Valley Cost of Freedom and presented Mr. Renzella with plaques for Cameron High and John Marshall High football teams' members' participation in assembling and disassembling the wall.

Certificates were presented to teachers and students from all schools.

The Board moved to JMHS Room 240 at 8:15 p.m. to conduct a student expulsion hearing.

President Lewicki announced that the Board would go into a closed session for the expulsion of SDA 12/13-06.

Mr. Thomas N. Wood proffered the student's case.

President Lewicki acted as Hearing Officer.

Motion by Mr. Miller and seconded by Mr. Gilbert that the Board go into closed session for the expulsion of SDA 12/13-06. Motion carried.
