The Marshall County Board of Education met in special session Thursday, March 29, 2012, 6:00 p.m., at the Offices of the Board of Education, all members having been notified of business to be considered.

Present were: Members Lori E. Kestner, Thomas E. Gilbert, Jr. and Beth A. Phillips; Secretary Alfred N. Renzella; Members of the County Administrative Staff, with President Roger Lewicki and Vice President David Hall being absent.

Mrs. Kestner announced that the Board would go into a closed session for the expulsion of SDA 11/12-15.

A Hearing Waiver was signed. Mr. Thomas N. Wood gave a proffer of the student's case.

Lori Kestner acted as Hearing Officer.

Motion by Mr. Gilbert and seconded by Mrs. Phillips that the Board go into closed session for the expulsion of SDA 11/12-15. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Gilbert and seconded by Mrs. Phillips that the Board come out of closed session and return to special session. Motion carried.

Superintendent Renzella's recommendation to the Board is that SDA 11/12-15 be expelled from John Marshall High School for a period not to exceed one school year.

Motion by Mrs. Phillips, seconded by Mr. Gilbert, and motion carried that the Board will uphold the Superintendent's recommendation to expel SDA 11/12-15 from John Marshall High School for a period not to exceed one school year.

This falls under the habitually violating school rules and policies West Virginia Code 18A-5-1a, the Safe School Statute.
