The Marshall County Board of Education met in special session Wednesday, April 27, 2011, 7:00 p.m., at the Offices of the Board of Education, all members having been notified of business to be considered.

Present were: President Roger A. Lewicki; Vice President David L. Hall; Members Thomas E. Gilbert, Jr., Lori E. Kestner, Beth A. Phillips; Secretary Alfred N. Renzella; Members of the County Administrative Staff.

A Hearing waiver was signed. Thomas Wood gave a proffer of the student's case.

President Lewicki announced that the Board would go into a closed session for the expulsion hearing.

President Lewicki acted as Hearing Officer.

Motion by Vice President Hall and seconded by Mr. Gilbert that the Board go into closed session for the expulsion hearing. Motion carried.

Superintendent Renzella's recommendation to the Board is that SDA 10/11-13 be expelled from Cameron High School for the remainder of the school year.

Motion by Mrs. Kestner, seconded by Mrs. Phillips, and motion carried that the Board will uphold the Superintendent's recommendation to expel SDA 10/11-13 from Cameron High School for the remainder of the school year.

This falls under the habitually violating school rules and policies West Virginia Code 18A-5-1a, the Safe School Statute.

Motion by Vice President Hall and seconded by Mrs. Kestner that the Board come out of closed session and return to special session. Motion carried.

Motion by Mrs. Kestner and seconded by Mrs. Phillips that the meeting be adjourned. Motion carried.
