The Marshall County Board of Education met in workshop session Thursday, August 22, 2013, 7:00 p.m., at the Offices of the Board of Education, all members having been notified of business to be considered.

Present were: President Roger A. Lewicki, Vice President Lori E. Kestner, Members Thomas E. Gilbert, Jr., John Miller, Beth A. Phillips; Secretary Michael Hince, Members of the County Administrative Staff.

The purpose of the workshop is to discuss goals for the Board of Education and the Superintendent.

The Board discussed with the Superintendent goals for both the Superintendent and the Board, each having at least two goals, one being mutual. The mutual goal would be to increase the communication between Marshall County Schools and the public of Marshall County.
