The Marshall County Board of Education met in special meeting/workshop session Thursday, August 26, 2010, 7:00 p.m., at the Offices of the Board of Education, all members having been notified of business to be considered.

Present were: President Roger A. Lewicki; Vice President David L. Hall; Members Thomas E. Gilbert, Jr., Lori E. Kestner and Beth A. Phillips; Secretary Alfred N. Renzella; Members of the County Administrative Staff.

Motion by Vice President Hall and seconded by Mrs. Kestner that the Board give permission to post half-time Math Teacher position at Cameron High School. Motion carried.

Rick Milhoan (PCS) and Gregg Dorfner (MKA) were present.

The Board explored and discussed the revised 2011 Needs Project. Mr. Milhoan and Mr. Dorfner shared with the Board a scaled down version from the original discussed project. Mr. Dorfner distributed a revised drawing showing the impact on the science rooms and the extension between the two buildings at John Marshall High School. The Board agreed and chose this package to be submitted to the SBA. The new estimate is approximately \$23 million. PCS will revise their estimates for this project.
