The purpose of this workshop is to discuss transitioning of students from Sand Hill Elementary to Hilltop Elementary.

Consol Energy was represented by Jordan Adkins, Denny Strickland, Brann and Jake Altmeyer. There was a review of the mining plan and timeline, the pre and post building inspection process and timeline; daily reporting of the mining progress to school officials and health and safety recommendations.

Marshall County Schools was represented by members of the county office administration and Chris Riley. Assistant Superintendent Wayne Simms reviewed the facility readiness of Hilltop to accommodate Sand Hill students and staff assignments. County office administrators also addressed concerns of transportation and the child nutrition program.
