The Marshall County Board of Education met in special session Wednesday, October 6, 2010, 7:30 p.m., at the Offices of the Board of Education, all members having been notified of business to be considered.

Present were: President Roger A. Lewicki; Vice President David L. Hall; Members Thomas E. Gilbert, Jr., Lori E. Kestner, and Beth A. Phillips; Secretary Alfred N. Renzella; Members of the County Administrative Staff.

A closed hearing was requested by the parent of Student Discipline Action 10/11-01.

President Lewicki announced that the Board would go into a closed hearing for the expulsion of SDA 10/11-01.

President Lewicki acted as Hearing Officer.

Present were: Richard S. Boothby, Esq. of *Bowles Rice McDavid Graff & Love LLP*, representing the Administration; and parent and student SDA 10/11-01.

Motion by Vice President Hall and seconded by Mrs. Kestner that the Board go into a closed hearing for the expulsion of SDA 10/11-01. Motion carried.

Superintendent Renzella's recommendation to the Board is that SDA 10/11-01 be expelled from John Marshall High School for a period not less than 12 consecutive months.

Motion by Mrs. Kestner, seconded by Mr. Gilbert, and motion carried that the Board will uphold the Superintendent's recommendation to expel SDA 10/11-01 from John Marshall High School for a period not less than 12 consecutive months.

This falls under the habitually violating school rules and policies West Virginia Code 18A-5-1a, the Safe School Statute.

Motion by Mr. Gilbert and seconded by Mrs. Phillips that the Board come out of closed session and return to special session. Motion carried.

As with all expulsions, the student will not be permitted to attend extracurricular functions associated with John Marshall High School during the length of the expulsion.
