Vice President Gilbert announced that the Board would go into a closed session for the expulsion of SDA 14/15-05.

Mr. Thomas N. Wood proffered the case. Mother and student were present.

Vice President Gilbert acted as Hearing Officer.

Motion by Mr. Miller, and seconded by Mrs. Kestner, that the Board go into closed session for the expulsion of SDA 14/15-05. Motion carried.

Motion by Mrs. Kestner, and seconded by Mr. Miller, that the Board come out of closed session and return to special session. Motion carried.

Superintendent Hince's recommendation to the Board is that SDA 14/15-05 be expelled from John Marshall High School for a period not to exceed one school year.

Motion by Mrs. Kestner, seconded by Mr. Miller and motion carried, that the Board will expel SDA 14/15-05 from John Marshall High School for a period not to exceed one school year.
