The Marshall County Board of Education met in workshop session Monday, December 16, 6:30 p.m., at the Offices of the Board of Education, all members having been notified of business to be considered.

Present were: President Roger A. Lewicki, Vice President Lori E. Kestner, Members Thomas E. Gilbert, Jr., John Miller, Beth A. Phillips; Secretary Michael Hince.

Also present were Larry Dunn, Rick Milhoan, Ron Blatt, Travis Arey, Jody Driggs and Brian Estep.

The purpose of the workshop is to review and discuss the design and costs of John Marshall High School Renovations provided by Silling.

Silling presented four options for the school's entrance and a design for the walkway between the main building and the Center for Performing Arts. The Board selected the entry way they liked best and approved the submitted design of the connector.

Silling met with Science Teachers and worked out a cost savings for the science labs and still maintain ten labs. The cost of the JMHS renovations will remain within the last budget approved. The cost of the main entry will be \$2.4 million and the cost of the connector will be \$2.3 million.

Motion by Mr. Miller, and seconded by Mrs. Phillips, that the meeting be adjourned. Motion carried.

President Lewicki adjourned the workshop at 8:30 p.m.
