The Marshall County Board of Education met in regular session Tuesday, October 8, 2019, 6:30 p.m., at Cameron Elementary, all members having been notified of business to be considered.

Present were: President John Miller, Vice President Christie Robison, Members Brenda Coffield, Lori E. Kestner, Dr. Duane Miller; Secretary Dr. Shelby Haines and Members of the County Administrative Staff.

A student expulsion hearing for student SDA 19/20-02 was conducted.

Meagan Kirchner, In-House Counsel, presented the case.

President Miller acted as Hearing Officer.

Mother and student were present. An open hearing was requested.

Faculty members of Cameron High School, Tim Brown, Joe Pettit and Matt Carnahan, spoke on behalf of the student's character and behavioral improvements.

Ms. Kirchner's recommendation to the Board is that SDA 19/20-02 be expelled from Cameron High School for a period not to exceed one school year, with a 45 day review.

Motion by Mrs. Kestner, and seconded by Dr. Miller, that SDA 19/20-02 will be expelled for a period not to exceed one school year, with a 45 day review.

This falls under the violating school rules and policies - West Virginia Code §18A-5-1a, the Safe School Statute.

Melissa Coffield addressed the Board regarding student bullying by a coach and strongly suggested that coaching evaluations are monitored closely.

Principal Wendy Clutter provided a tour of Cameron Elementary as the school's Local School Improvement Council presentation.

Counselor Kelly Pettit spoke on behalf of the Local School Improvement Council for Cameron High School. Mrs. Pettit presented a power point highlighting the high school's programs and achievements. Mrs. Schwertfeger spoke regarding STEM and vocabulary projects at the high school.
