Superintendent's Report

The first meeting of the Marshall County Task Force on Racial Discrimination was held on Monday, October 10th. There were 12 persons in attendance including, community members, school officials, elected officials, and parents. There was input from students. The group has decided to focus on racial discrimination at this time. The group had a very open discussion focused on how to make change and what steps are needed to move forward. The group wants to be an active group focusing on output and community change. Some of the ideas on how to make change included ways for people to make reports confidentially, building student groups, mediation, participating in the NAACP state wide initiatives, publications and programs to name a few. Team members were sent home with "homework" and will report back in one month.

Tuesday, October 11th is Girls in STEM day at John Marshall High School. This is specific to "Girls in Stem" as that is how the grant money was funded. This will afford all 5th grade female students the opportunity to see what STEM opportunities are available in Marshall County Schools.

Wednesday, October 12th is a Professional Learning Day in the county and we have a number of great trainings going on for service and professional personnel. PL Days are site-based trainings, led by the principal. Many schools are focusing on student performance data and looking the priority standards and how they cross reference to low or high performance on the general summative assessment.
