There will be a number of opportunities for students of Marshall County Schools over the summer. MCS will offer special education and Title I summer school from June 21 – July 21 at Gateway Achievement Center. MCS also supports offerings at Grand Vue adventure camps with general programming money, meals, transportation, tutoring and scholarships. Many of the schools have tutoring at their schools and week-long STEM/Science camps at no charge for students. MCS will also be offering online Health I and Health II as well as summer gym.

We have a number of training opportunities for teachers this summer including the WVDE mandated training on Canvas related to special education. We also are working on some trainings for elementary teachers on data analysis.

We will be rolling out the Activities Pass for Marshall County residents. Residents will visit the Marshall County Schools Board of Education office any Wednesday, between June 7 and July 26, 2023, from 10:00 am until 6:00 pm to get their picture taken for the personalized activity pass. A proof of residency **must** be presented. Parents of elementary students, will be asked to bring their child to the BOE Office when applying for the activity pass, as each pass must include the pass holder's picture. Elementary students must get an activity pass when their parent or guardian apply. Children under the age of five do not need a pass and will be admitted for free. Senior citizens wishing to gain free admission to ALL county sanctioned events must upgrade their current county issued Senior Citizen Pass. Persons must bring their county-issued activity pass to each event to be granted free admission. You will not be permitted to use someone else's activity pass.

The Marshall County Schools Activity Pass is good for admission only. There may be additional fees at events such as parking, donations, concessions, souvenirs and more. The free activity pass is made possible, in part, by the generosity of the Marshall County citizens who supported the renewal of the operating levy.
